Question 1: Have you been personally impacted by this series *beyond the harbour*? Why/Why not?

Question 2: Share what you believe is the most challenging aspect of going *beyond the harbour* for you or for us as a church.

Read Jeremiah 29:4-7 together

Question 3: As a group discuss what stands out to you in this reading.

Question 4: Has there been a time in your life where you've been so focussed on what was next that you missed out on opportunities along the way? (learning opportunities, opportunities for joy etc.)

Question 5: On Sunday Tim said that everyone has something they can contribute. Do you agree? In what ways can you contribute to what God is doing?

Question 6: Our passage in Jeremiah tells us to **seek** the welfare of the city. In what ways are you seeking or can you be seeking the welfare of your community?

Question 7: Discuss the meaning of *for in its welfare you will find your welfare* (v.7 ESV). What is the likely impact of a healthier community (physically & spiritually) on Mayfield Church of Christ?

Our passage this week tells us to **Pray to the Lord on its [the city's] behalf**. Spend some time in prayer praying for the community of Mayfield. Discuss anything that God is showing you. Can we reach 1% of our community (150 people)? How?
